

Planned and in-progress **Drinking Water Capital Improvements** for the Next Three Years in New Jersey will Total

\$4,712,166,552

Based on 211 responses to the 2022 WQAA Capital Improvement Report, representing 88 percent of all drinking water customers statewide

The capital improvements for most utilities will **cost between** a few hundred dollars and a few thousand dollars per connection.



A handful of utilities have planned and in-progress projects totaling tens of thousands of dollars per connection.

The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law is touted as a **“once-in-a-generation”** investment in water infrastructure, giving New Jersey an additional \$92 Million this year for drinking water infrastructure. But **the need from systems** is far greater.
